## APHIS Extends Deadline for Opportunity for Partners to Develop Antimicrobial Resistance Dashboards to Protect Animal and Public Health

Due to upcoming maintenance on the <u>Grants.gov</u> site, the U.S Department of Agriculture's Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service (APHIS) is extending the deadline for partners to submit applications to collaborate on the development of antimicrobial resistance (AMR) dashboards. Applicants now have until 11:59 p.m. EST on May 28, 2024 to submit applications.

APHIS <u>announced the open period for this opportunity</u> on March 19, 2024. These dashboards provide stakeholders with critical data to address AMR, a growing global health threat. APHIS will provide up to \$3 million dollars for these efforts in 2024.
