<b>The official veterinarian certifies for export that all Columbiformes covered under this health certificate were inspected by the examining veterinarian issuing the health certificate and:</b>		
<div>1. <input type="checkbox"/> During the 90 days prior to export, the Columbiformes to be exported have continuously resided on a single premises in the country of export that is under my supervision.</div> <div>OR</div> <div><input type="checkbox"/> The Columbiformes have not resided in the country of export for 90 days prior to export and I have reviewed health certificate(s) endorsed by the competent authority for animal health of the additional county or countries and confirmed that the conditions specified in this certificate were met during the full 90 days.<sup>1</sup></div> <div>OR</div> <div><input type="checkbox"/> The Columbiformes have resided on multiple premises in the country of export during the 90 days prior to export and I have reviewed health certificates(s) endorsed by an authorized veterinarian or the competent authority of animal health confirming that the conditions specified in this certificate were met during the full 90 days.<sup>1</sup></div> <div>2. Were inspected on the premises of origin prior to movement of the shipment for export and were found to be clinically free of signs of communicable diseases of poultry,</div><div>b. Were not vaccinated for any H5 or H7 subtype of avian influenza, and</div><div>c. Were kept in the region of export until offered for import.</div></div> <div>3.
