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The official veterinarian certifies for export that the flock of origin for the hatching eggs covered under this health certificate were inspected by the examining veterinarian issuing the health certificate and:

1. The flock of origin for the hatching eggs was not vaccinated against any H5 or H7 subtype of avian influenza.
2. The flock of origin for the hatching eggs:

☐ Was not vaccinated against Newcastle disease (avian paramyxovirus).

3. The flock of origin for the hatching eggs presented no evidence of communicable disease of poultry within the 30 days prior to the hatching of the first egg laid for this shipment.
4. The hatching eggs were exported from an area that was not under quarantine during the 90 days preceding the exportation.

The poultry hatching eggs covered by this certificate do not originate from, nor have they transited through, any region which APHIS considers affected with highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI), and no cases of HPAI or Newcastle disease occurred on the premises where the poultry hatching eggs were kept, or on adjoining premises, during the 90 days immediately preceding export.
6. The flock or flock(s) of origin is negative within the previous 90 days for:
 - Avian metapneumovirus (also known as Turkey Rhinotracheitis, (TRT), or Swollen Head Syndrome): At least 30 poultry per house were tested using any of the following methods: rRT-PCR, ELISA, or serology.

12. The hatching eggs were placed in new or appropriately sanitized packaging for shipment to the United States at the premises where the flock or origin was kept.
13. The shipment will not transit through any region where APHIS considers HPAI to exist.
